Rain City Rock Camp for Girls Summer Camp is a day camp for girls ages 8-16. Girls come for a weeklong crash course in playing an instrument, songwriting, zine making, self-defense and more! At the end of the week, campers get to perform their original song with their band at a local live music venue. Campers do not need to have any prior music experience, and instruments will be provided.

WHO MAY APPLY FOR CAMP

Any girl who will be ages 8-16 *during the camp session* may apply. No experience is necessary, and you don't have to live in Seattle or Washington State to apply (please see below for more information on out-of-town campers).

INSTRUMENT INSTRUCTION

At camp, you can choose to study guitar, bass, drums, or vocals. Please indicate your first, second, and third choices of instrument on the application. Due to the need to acquire gear in advance, you cannot change your selection after you send in your application and you cannot change during the camp session. **Instruments will be provided for use during the camp week. If you have your own instrument, please feel free to bring it.** Please note that Rain City Rock Camp for Girls does not accept liability for personal instruments.
